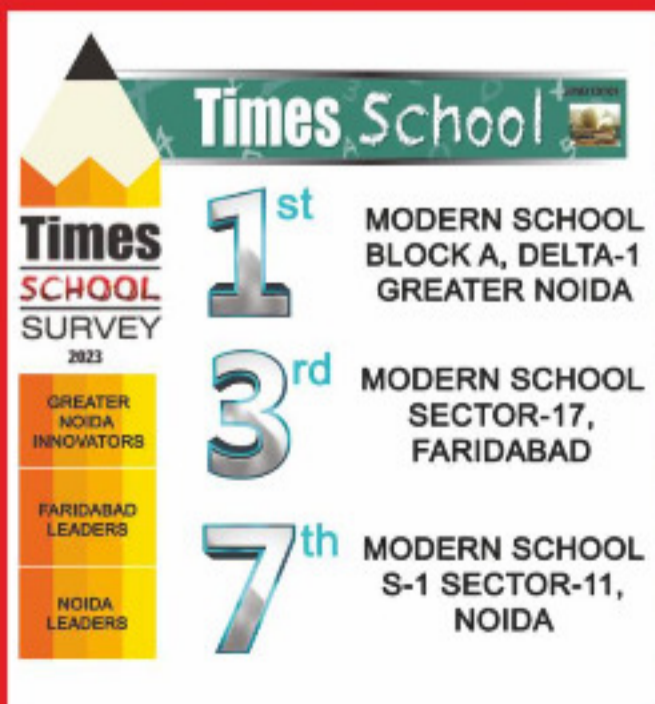

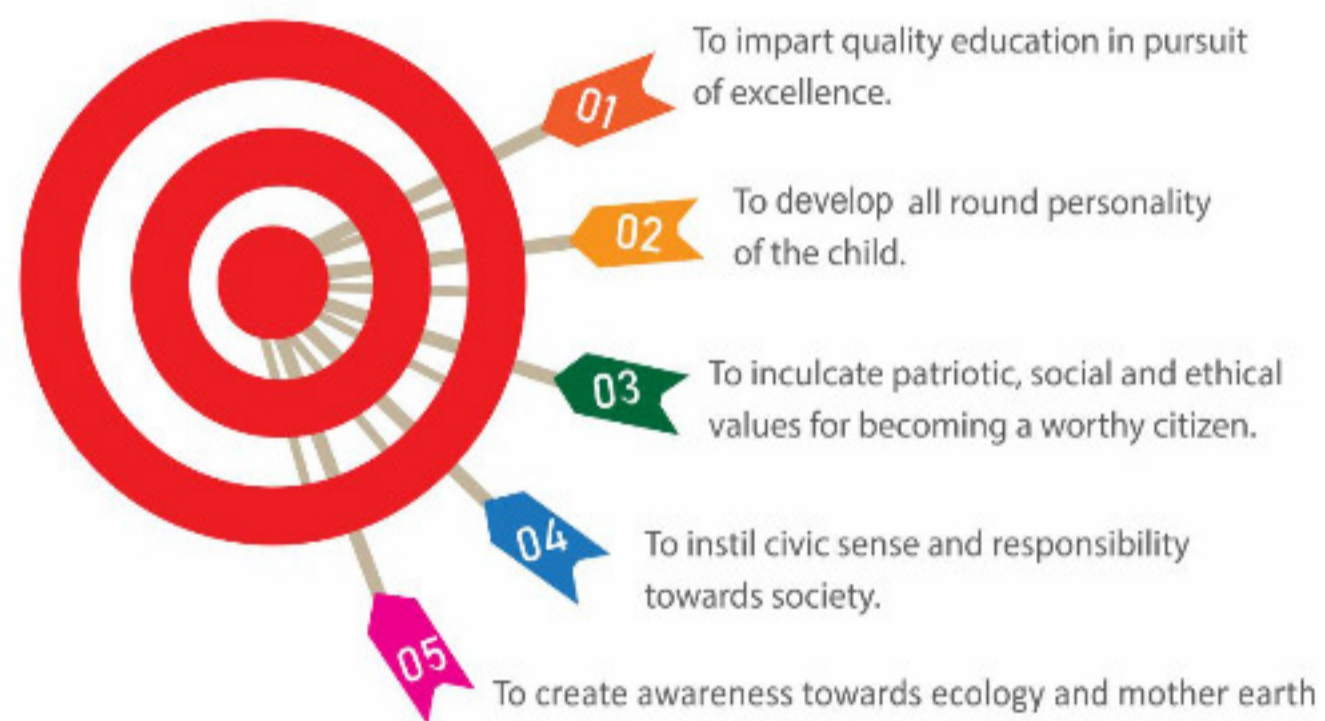

Literary activities like dramatics, debates, declamation & quiz are organised at intra, inter school, district & state level to infuse leadership qualities in the students.

School's Annual Function, Sports Day, Science Fair, Parent's Day, Grandparent's Day, Exclusive Mother's Day, Tiny-Tots Function, School Fete, Annual Appreciation Day, Investiture Day, Convocation Day etc. are regularly organised and are well appreciated by the parents and eminent guests.

Proctor, Head Girl, Head Boy, Chief Prefect Sports, Cultural Coordinators, Captains, Vice Captains, Prefects, Class Monitors and Brother Head Boy & Sister Head girl do their best to prove themselves as role models before the Student Community.

They shoulder all the responsibilities with the school administration specially pertaining to discipline, organising various activities, functions and implementing various policies of the school in the best interest of the students.

With an aim to provide ample opportunities to the students to show their various hidden talents and developing qualities of leadership, co-operation, self confidence, adjustment and a healthy competitive spirit, the entire school is horizontally divided into five Houses.

Various intra house and inter house activities are organised throughout the year in a well spaced manner.

Other Facilities of the School

Medical

The school provides facilities of a health clinic under the charge of a well qualified and experienced medical officer. Every student has to undergo a medical check-up or take advice twice a year. A health card is maintained for each child and intimation is sent to the parents for further follow up.

A student returning to school after suffering from any disease has to submit a medical fitness certificate from a qualified Doctor.

Key Parameters of Child Safety

GPS Trackers installed in the school buses allow the school administrators and parents to monitor the real - time location of school buses. For the safety and convenience of the girl children, one maid (ayah) has been deployed on

all bus routes. CCTV cameras have been installed on all the prime locations and areas of accessibility for close monitoring to give a safe premises to the child. The whole school is now under CCTV surveillance.

Keeping in mind the needs of CWSN and elderly people, the school

has provided the facility of ramp and elevator under the guidelines laid by NDMA. To avoid any accident fire hose systems have been fitted in every wing of the school. Besides, various Committees- Grievance Redressal Committee, POCSO Committee and Disaster Management Committee etc. are functional in the institution to ensure the overall safety of children and women staff workers.

Admission Procedure

Admissions are generally accepted in class Nursery and class XI. Admissions to other classes are subject to availability of seats in the desired class. The minimum age for admission to Nursery class is 3 plus as on April 1st of that year, Admission to higher classes is made on the basis of admission test and personal interaction with the pupil and their parents/guardians.

Every student seeking admission, is required to apply on the prescribed application form along with the following certificates/documents.

- (1) Vaccination and birth certificate (original) for class Nursery, K.G. and Class Ist only.
- (2) School Leaving Certificate duly countersigned by the education authorities of the district/state.
- (3) Progress report from the school last attended.
- (4) Aadhar Cards of child & parents.

Note : Being a minority institution, priority in admission will be given to JAINS. However, preference is also given to candidates belonging to SC/ST/OBC/EWS and other categories based on merit only.

Courses of Studies

The school prepares students from class Nursery to class XII as per the scheme of C.B.S.E., New Delhi. Following streams of education for class XI & XII are available.

1. Science : Medical
2. Science : Non-Medical
3. Humanities
4. Commerce

The school offers these streams of education with a choice of optional subjects. The school has made inhouse arrangements for integrated coaching for various competitive and entrance examinations like IIT-JEE, NEET, NDA, CA, CPT, NTSE, Olympiads etc. by a team of competent faculty right from the beginning.

Fee Rules

Fee and funds have to be deposited in advance and on quarterly basis i.e. upto **10th day of April, July, October & January**. Payments are to be made either in cash at the cash counter of the school or through an Account

Transport

Presently, School buses are plying on scheduled routes. Admission to the school does not necessarily mean allocation of a seat in the school bus. In case of the change of residence, adjustment to another bus cannot be guaranteed. Bus users are advised to reach the boarding point 10 minutes before the scheduled time. No discontinuation of bus facility and refund is allowed during the academic session. Eleven months charges are to be paid by the students during the session. In case of indiscipline, the transport facility can be withdrawn any time at the sole discretion of the Principal without refund of balance.

Uniform

No student is allowed to attend the school and board the school bus without proper school uniform. Parents are requested to go through the details of the uniform specified in the student's diary. Three sets of summer and two sets of winter uniform are compulsory. In order to maintain uniformity, school has arranged tailoring facilities at very reasonable charges. Parents can deposit the charges in the following months. However this is optional.

For Summer - in February

For Winter - in September

Fee Concession

Application on prescribed forms are generally invited during the month of July every year for fresh concession or for renewal. The school allows fee concession to the students on the basis of means and merit. Special consideration is given for granting fee concession to the SC/ST/OBC and other pupils from the weaker sections of society. Freeship, concessions and incentives upto 100% are being allowed to the deserving and high achievers in the field of Academics, Sports, Arts and Culture.

Dr. S.D. Jain Memorial Scholarship

Class I to V : Top two students of each class with minimum 90% marks or above in the Final promotional result shall get scholarship of Rs. 5100/- at the time of Annual Function.

Class VI to VIII : Top two students of each class with minimum 85% marks or above in the Final promotional result shall get scholarship of Rs. 5100/- at the time of Annual Function.

However, incentive and scholarship policy shall be reviewed every year.

Payee's cheque in favour of **MODERN SCHOOL** drawn on local banks only. Fees and Funds can also be deposited online through the **website www.modernschoolfaridabad.com / school ERP App.**

Cheques shall be accepted upto 7th day of each quarter. However, fee for the month of April/at the time of Admission shall only be accepted through cash/D.D. In case the cheque is dishonoured, the bank charges along with the penalty have to be borne by the parents/guardians. Fees and funds once paid are not refundable/adjustable under any circumstances. Parents are advised not to send fee through students in cash.

Late Fee

From 12th day of the month to 20th day of the month - Rs. 50/- Per Day. Later from 21st day of the month upto last day of the month - Rs. 100/- per day. Later, the name shall be struck off from the roll on the last working day of the month. Re-admission can be considered solely on Principal's discretion after paying Re-admission fee Rs. 5000/- upto 5th day of the month. After 5th no claim of seat will be considered.

Caution Money

Caution money is to be deposited by every pupil at the time of admission and is refundable at the time of withdrawal or on completion of studies in the school. It should be claimed along with the original deposit receipt within three months from the date of leaving the school.

Withdrawal from the School

A clear one month notice in writing or one month fee in lieu of the notice is necessary for the withdrawal of the student from the school during the academic session. School Transfer Certificate will be issued only after clearing all outstanding dues.

Suspension / Discontinuation from the School

Student can be put on suspension / discontinuation after disciplinary action taken or for continuous failure in the same class for consecutive 2 years.

Re-Admission

An application giving reasons for seeking re-admission may be considered by the Principal at his/her sole discretion upto 5th of the following month. Re-admission fees alongwith all outstanding dues have to be paid by the parents at the time of re-admission. The Principal may refuse re-admission without assigning any reason.

Parent Teacher Meeting

Representative of parents and teachers are consulted on vital issues as and when required for the optimum development of the child. Meetings with class and subject teachers are held on every 2nd Saturday of the month. Such meetings are very conducive and healthy for the progress of the children.

Disciplinary Committee

The school has constituted POCSO (Prevention of Children from Sexual Offences) and disciplinary committee comprising of Principal, Vice Principal, Co-ordinators, two teachers, P.T.I., Proctor, Head Boy / Girl, and one parent representative to deal with the cases of gross indiscipline reported / detected in the school. The decision of the committee shall be binding and final.

Evaluation and Promotion

The evaluation system enables continuous assessment. Promotion is granted on the basis of overall performance of the child during the whole year. Periodic Tests and weekly tests are regularly conducted and given weightage in the final promotion. Keeping pace with the changing curriculum and to provide stress free atmosphere, policy of 'No home work & No bags' has been introduced up to class 2nd.

To facilitate the students coming from different parts of the country and even from abroad, a HOSTEL with all modern facilities has been provided within the School Campus. Airy, Well Ventilated, Beautiful, Centrally Air cooled / Air-conditioned / Rooms have been provided for 100 girls and 100 boys in separate buildings. Seats are limited. Candidates have to register themselves for the hostel accommodation.

Student's Account

Personal and Medical Account

A separate amount of Rs. 6000/- in each account is to be kept with the school to meet the day to day expenses on books / stationery and of personal nature.

Code of Conduct

Strict discipline has to be observed while staying in Hostel.

Breach of rules and disobedience to the authorities will lead to expulsion from the hostel / school.

No one is allowed to go out to market without an escort and permission.

Night out is not allowed. Students are allowed to go home during summer, autumn and winter holidays as per the schedule given separately.

Guests are not allowed to stay with the student in the hostel.

For keeping healthy atmosphere and strict discipline, the boarders have to get their belongings checked by the guard while coming and going out. Parents are requested to submit the list of articles / belongings of their ward to the warden at the time of admission or as and when there is change. All belongings should be marked for identification.

No one can bring articles other than prescribed ones. No personal medicines / tonic except that prescribed by the attending Doctors is allowed in the hostel premises.

Parents are advised not to give ornaments and articles like Press (Iron) Mobile Phone, I-pads, Laptop, heater etc. Such items will be seized and the school shall not be responsible for any loss or damage.

Meeting the Ward

Parents / guardians may meet their wards once in a month i.e. On 2nd Saturday between 10.00 a.m. to 4.00 p.m. or with due permission of the Principal on any other day.

Only authorised relatives/close friends can be accepted as local guardian/visitors to visit or meet the child in the hostel. Three such persons as his/her local guardian signing the admission form can be authorised including parents to visit their wards and meet the teachers.

Fine / Penalty

Late joining after leave or vacation will be charged @ Rs. 200/- only per day. Absence without permission for more than 4 days from the school and hostel may lead to the discontinuation from Hostel/School. The school will not entertain any claim for seat or for refund after that.

Withdrawal from the Hostel

One month's clear notice or one month's hostel charges are to be paid for withdrawal in the middle of session. Such withdrawal may be allowed on payment of lodging charges at the rate of Rs. 500/- per month for the rest of session with outstanding balance, if any.

For NRI / Foreign Students

1. Passport and valid residential permit are required to be deposited with the school at the time of admission.
2. It is the sole responsibility of the parents / guardians to ensure that the validity of Passport and Visa covers the entire period of Academic Session.

Legal Disputes

All disputes are subject to the jurisdiction of Distt. Court at Faridabad (Haryana) India only.

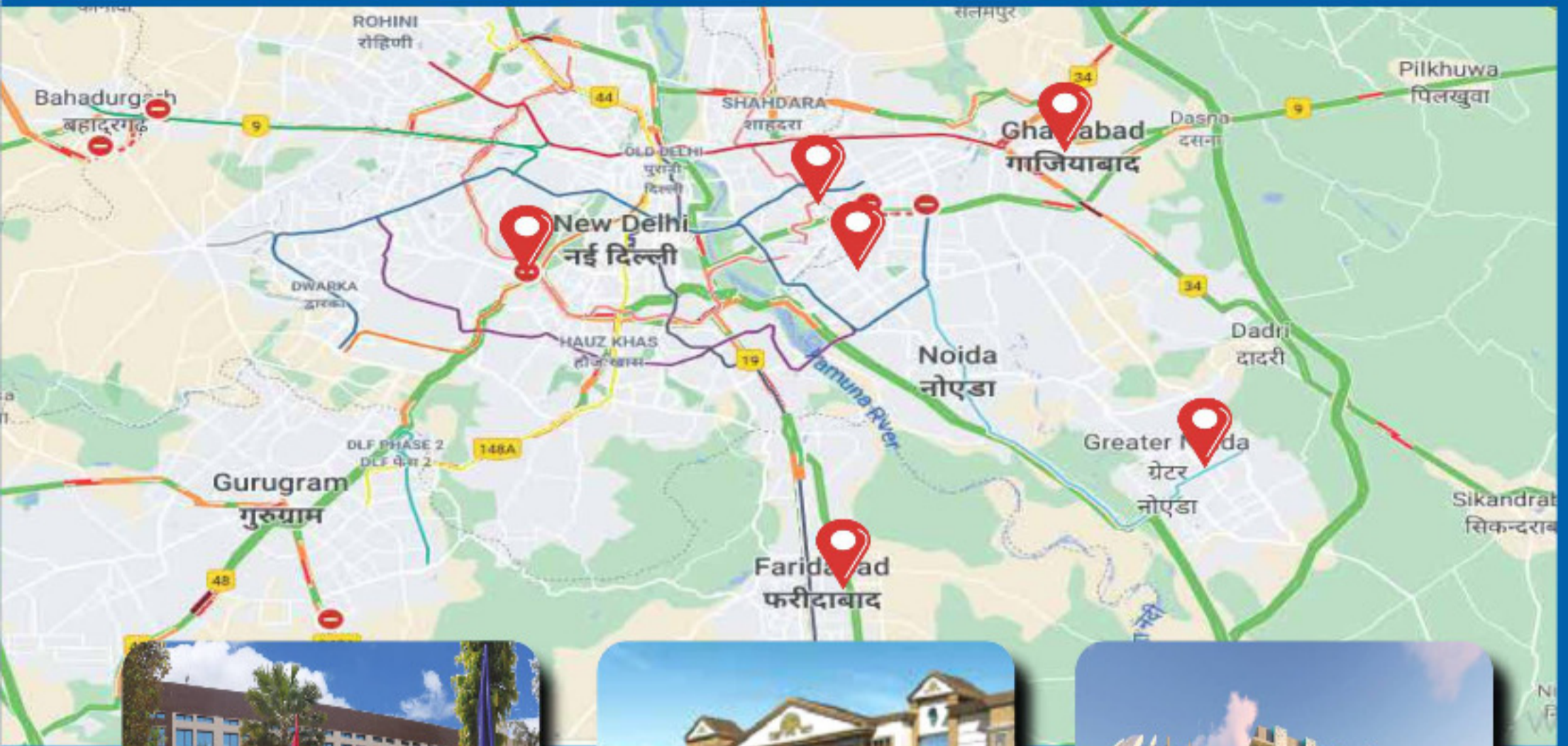
